Within the body of the Email message sent to Bud, please respond to these questions:

1. What prompted you to apply to attend Camp Enterprise?
2. What are your career and life goals?
3. Have you had any exposure to business (summer jobs etc.)? Please list.
4. Please provide an example of the types of courses that you are currently taking at school that are related to your entrepreneurial interests and how they are going to assist you in your future.
5. Have you had a formal interview before? Please describe your experience.
6. What do you see as the most critical issues facing young people today?
7. Please describe/list your experience in working in a group or as team?
8. Does the applicant have any experience in community-related volunteering? Please List.
9. Applicant must have a good performance/record at school and can be excused for the time period for Camp Enterprise. Confirmation from Parents/School will be required.
10. Would you be willing to present your Camp Enterprise experiences to the Rotary Club of Brampton South?
11. Would you be willing to present your experiences to a grade 11 class or assembly?
12. Does the applicant have any experience with Interact or Roteract?
(Interact is a High-School based community-service Student Club and Roteract is a University based community-service Student Club that are affiliated with a local Rotary Club.....)
