

#### Uganda age structure

As of the beginning of 2017 according to our estimates Uganda had the following population age distribution

49.9 48.1 2.1

- percentage of population under 15

- percentage of population between 15 and 64 years old

- percentage of population 65+

In absolute figures (estimate):

- 20 418 581 young people under 15 years old ( 10 284 645 males / 10 133 526 females)
- 19 687 561 persons between 15 and 64 years old ( 9 919 340 males / 9 767 812 females)
- 847 737 persons above 64 years old ( 344 828 males / 502 499 females)

Uganda's Population is 40 Million 50% of the population is Under 15 years of age. Aids has decimated a generation in many areas.

There are an estimated 2.5 Million orphaned children, 1.2 million of them are Aids orphans, meaning both parents have died of Aids.


Rotary club of Guelph Trillium has supported 3 years of treatment in various communities run by CHFU, helping over 2500 people
