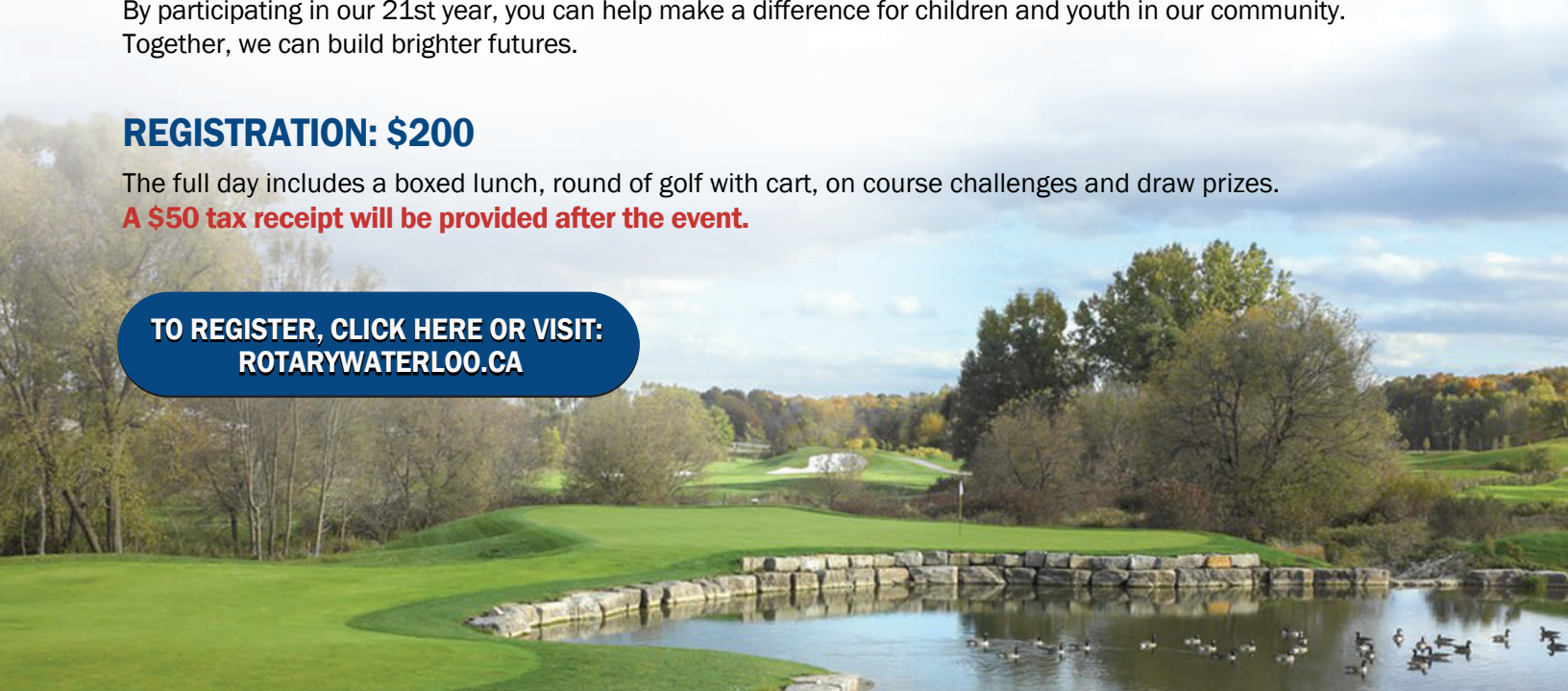

# COVID-19 Protocols

## REBEL CREEK GOLF CLUB AND ROTARY WATERLOO

### On Course Protocols

- All golf carts will be provided with dividers and sanitized before the event.
- Sanitizing wipes or hand sanitizer will be provided in each cart.
- The putting cup will be modified to prevent your ball from dropping into the hole for retrieval.
- All rakes, ball washers, and any other fixtures will be removed from the golf course.
- Always leave the pin in and avoid all unnecessary touchpoints.
- Continuous putting is encouraged to promote social distancing while on the green.
- Keep a minimum two-metre distance from your playing partners and refrain from shaking hands after your round or any other physical contact.
- Refrain from picking up playing partners' clubs or golf balls.

### Facility Protocols

- One person in the washroom at any given time.
- All registration processes and participant interaction will be completed outside or in an indoor area with limited access.
- If possible, it is encouraged to have only one person check-in for the entire group to help maintain social distancing.
- Once registered, groups will not proceed to the first tee until instructed to do so.
- Countertops, payment units, door handles, and any other surfaces in contact with the public will be repeatedly sanitized.
