# Al Hopper Friend of Rotary – Deadline for Submissions – September 15, 2017

This award is named after a past President, the late Al Hopper, of our club. The award is presented to a non-Rotarian who has greatly enhanced the success of a club project or objective, whether through loyal contributions of time and effort over years, or through an especially notable contribution made for one particular project. They will be recognized with a personal plaque. Nominations are only accepted by members of the Rotary Club of Barrie. Al Hopper was the Executive Director of the Barrie YMCA and an extraordinary volunteer leader who always put service above self.

## Vocational Service Award – Deadline for Submissions – November 17, 2017

The Vocational Service Award is presented to an individual in the community for fulfillment of the Rotary ideal of Service, who has shown outstanding achievement in their vocation by encouraging high ethical standards and by dignifying that vocation as an opportunity to serve society. This award does not require that the person under consideration be a member of any Rotary Club or to be in a managerial or ownership position. Anyone who stands out in his or her vocation and who exemplifies the Rotary Ideal of Service will be considered.

## Volunteer of the Year Award – Deadline for Submissions – January 19, 2018

This award is intended to recognize an individual in our community who has given their time and energy towards a community service over a long period of time without remuneration. If you know of a personal who has demonstrated a long record of community service to one or more organizations or humanitarian causes then you are encouraged to submit their names to the Vocational Service Committee of the Rotary Club of Barrie. They will be recognized by the club President with a personal plaque and a donation to the charity of their choice.

### Outstanding Teacher of the Year – Deadline for Submissions – February 23, 2018

This award is presented to a Barrie teacher for demonstrating outstanding performance in motivating students, setting a good example of high ethical standards and community service above self. The award is given in recognition of that level of performance exemplifying vocational excellence. The winning teacher receives from the club president a plaque the teacher can display and a donation to a charity of their choice.

### Military Service Above Self Award – Submissions by Base Borden Commanders only

This honours an active member of the Military for voluntary service even beyond their service in the forces. Borden Base Commanders are asked to submit nominations, which are then sent to the Vocational Committee for decision. We try to award this as part of a Remembrance Day meeting.

Rotarians are encouraged to nominate community members for the above awards. Feel free to talk to a vocational service committee member for more information or a nomination form.
