

## Rotary Club of Haliburton

## Funding Guidelines

Funding decisions will be made based on a number of requirements and considerations and should:

- 1. Relate to ideals, mission, and areas of focus of Rotary International, Rotary Foundation, Rotary District 7010, or the Rotary Club of Haliburton.
- 2. Exclude any liability to the Rotary Club of Haliburton except for the funding amount of the grant.
- 3. Adhere to governing laws of Canada and any other country where the activity is taking place.
- 4. Comply with Conflict of Interest and Conflict of Duty policy of Rotary Club of Haliburton.
- 5. Comply with current Club priorities, and budgets.
- 6. Endeavour to provide tools and education to foster capacity for skill development and education.

Funding will not normally be granted to projects or requests for:

- 1. Projects that are considered to be multi-year support of any one beneficiary, entity, or community.
- 2. Operating, administration or indirect program expenses of another organization.
- 3. Unrestricted cash donations to a beneficiary or cooperating organization.
- 4. Projects already completed.
- 5. Related to the purchase of land or buildings.
- 6. Fundraising activities of fundraising organizations which employ paid staff.
- 7. Humanitarian projects which consist primarily of research data or collection.
