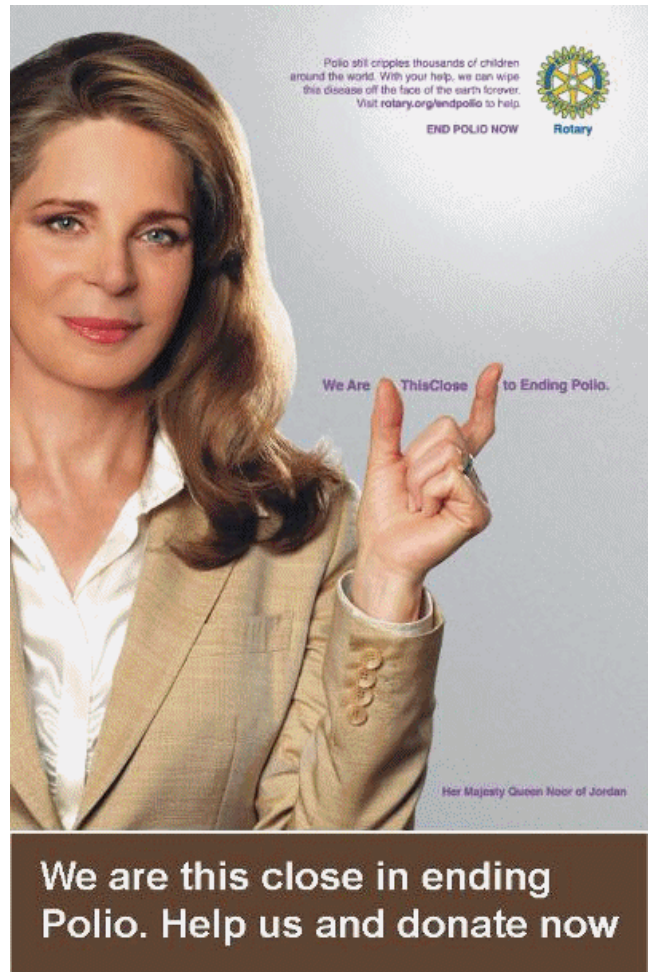
catches you with the wrong one,
