President Adam's Updates:



When Rotary formed PolioPlus in 1985 to end Polio, Polio paralyzed 1,000 children every single day in 125 polio-endemic countries. Because vaccines work, just 2 countries remain endemic. To date this year there has been **one** documented case of Polio in Afghanistan and none in Pakistan! We are very close to making history. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation continues to match donations 2:1.
