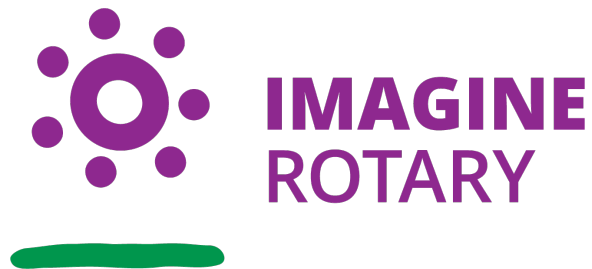

**Guest Speaker:** Wait up a minute! Our **Treasurer, John Bennett's** no guest but he does have some financial information for us. John distributed a report detailing Profit and Loss and a Balance Sheet. John noted in particular that our annual dues presently **do not** cover the expense of

liability insurance and dues levied by District and Rotary International. John also noted a substantial donation from Polito Ford relative to receipts from rental of the “Santa” parade float as well as District grant of \$3000 to Wilson Fields washroom project, thus reducing the club cost to \$3000; also a Federal grant of \$100,000 toward the Memorial Park washroom project.

A couple of housekeeping motions made were:

- receive the report as presented; Carried
- cancel our requirement for annual financial statement prepared by BDO as they already supply bookkeeping services gratis; Carried
- “file” the request from Food Source for \$1500 for a school meals program. After some discussion a friendly amendment to donate \$1000 and revisit after expected successful fundraising efforts are completed; Carried
- “file” a request for donation from Red Cross. Carried
