Kelly Isfan celebrated her birthday Aug. 1st

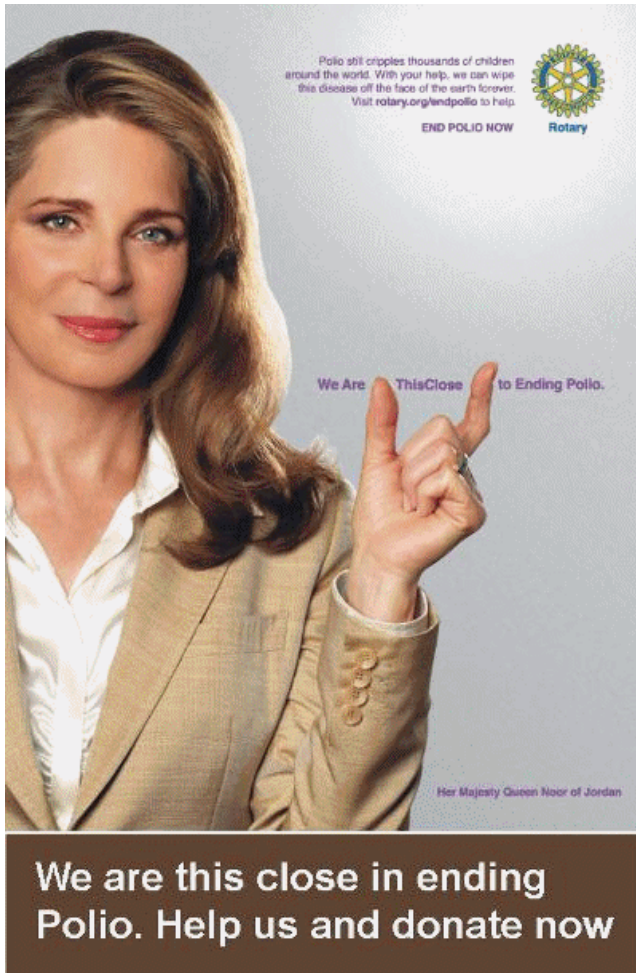
Gary Traill's birthday was August 5th.

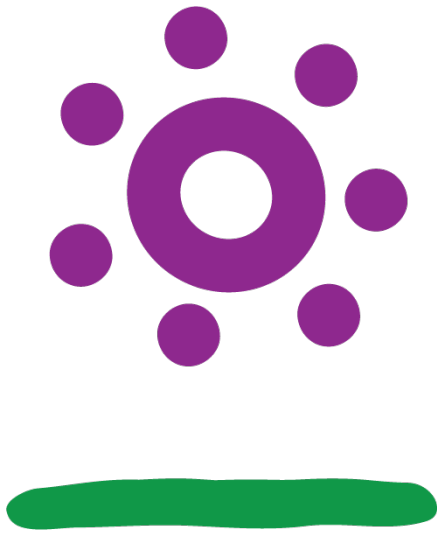
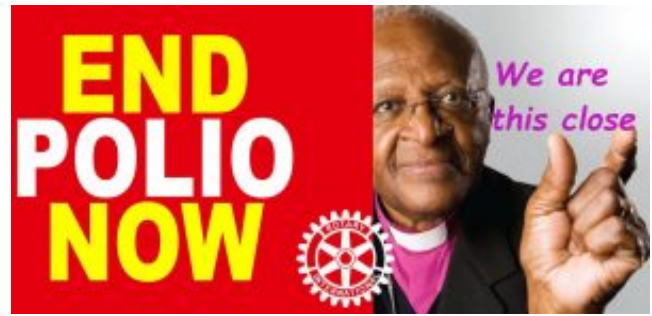
