Our Impact in North Bay

- 750 employees (441 in North Bay and surrounding areas)
- 190 employees work at the North Bay Shop Complex
- \$50M annual payroll (\$26.6M in North Bay)
- \$2.11 multiplier effect in each community!
 \$56.1M in economic benefit to North Bay

Our Impact in North Bay

- Motor Coach 260,000 (70,000 passengers/year to and from North Bay)
- 4,700 bus departures/arrivals
- 39,000 rail cars in, out or through North Bay in 2014
