Today's Speaker: President-Elect Ken Tremblay

Because the scheduled speaker Mike Skinner cancelled this morning Ken agreed to give an overview of the Rotary Leadership weekend in North Bay. He urged us to consider attending the RI Convention in Toronto to join the 350 Rotarians from District 7010. Kevin Duguay was hard at work signing up clubs to sell the Rotary beer. To date the beer is being sold in 58 beer stores! The district is considering adding a \$10 fee the membership fee to help defray the expenses which continue to increase, this year's budget had \$500,000 in expenditures. We so have representation at the District, *ADG RICK* STOREY, Wayne Harding Chair of Youth Exchange and BEL Rotarian incoming DG Sue Davidson. Issues our club needs to consider include attendance, membership retention, and the format for club meetings. Ken told us about the the 17 member Rotaract club of Nipissing raising \$70,000. 11 clubs out of the 43 in District 7010 have Rotaract clubs. ADG Rick Storey urged us to consider attending the District Conference at Deerhurst Oct 19-21. Ken will be presenting more detailed plans for the upcoming Rotary year in his presentation April 30.

Before adjourning the meeting, *President Andi* reminded us of the Celebration of Life for Willis Cleveland Sat April 21 3-5 pm. To date 44 Rotarians are attending. The PH dinner is Nov 3, site to be determined After a straw vote, it was decided to invite the 4 local candidates to speak at a meeting leading up to the provincial election.
