THE MONARCH ULTRA RELAY RUN:

→ 4,300KM (2,671 MI) TOTAL DISTANCE COVERED IN THE ULTRA MARATHON.

→ 438 ROADSIDE AID STOPS WHERE MONARCH ULTRA CREW PROVIDED WATER, ENERGY GELS, SNACKS & EMOTIONAL SUPPORT TO THE RUNNERS.
