Things to know before joining our Rotary Club:

Annual Dues: The Rotary Year runs from 1st July to the following 30th June. Annual Dues, currently \$260, are payable on 1st July each year. Members joining later in the Rotary Year pay a pro-rata amount based on the number of full months remaining before the following 30th June. There are concessions for spouses of members, and for members under 30.

Meetings: Generally we meet weekly on Thursdays for Dinner at 6.30 pm. (Meal cost average \$25) We gather for social time from 6.00 pm onwards. Our normal meeting place is the Coastal Room at Gibsons Public Market, although we do occasionally meet at other venues including local restaurants or featured business locations. Meetings consist of Dinner and a Guest Speaker or a Club Meeting when we discuss Club Business and plan Projects.

Attendance: Members should attend as often as possible and a minimum of 2 meetings per month is expected unless the member is away from Gibsons for an extended period, or is prevented by illness.

Teams: Discuss with your sponsor your participation in the Club. We have the following Teams for you to choose from (once you have had a chance to familiarize yourself with the Club) and we expect every member to join at least one of the Teams as well as being involved with Fund Raisers and Projects.
