The Rotary Club of Langley makes grants available for Langley and international projects. In most cases, grants are only for projects in one of Rotary's six Areas of Focus:

- Peace and conflict prevention / resolution
- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water and sanitation
- Maternal and child health
- Basic educational and literacy
- Economic and community development

Most grants are only made to Registered Charities or Registered Not-for-Profit societies. Grants for sports organizations will also be considered. Grants to individuals are rarely made, and then only for "humanitarian relief work" in one of the Areas of Focus.

Grants for travel to conventions and conferences will not be considered.

To apply for a grant, complete the Grant Application Form, available on our website, and submit it along with supporting documents.

Expect that grant applications will take AT LEAST two months to process, sometimes longer. The club has limited funds available, therefore even if the project would otherwise qualify for a grant, it may not be approved.
