

2022 COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Rotary Club of White Rock (<u>https://www.whiterockrotary.org/</u>) has established four scholarships in 2022 for residents of White Rock and South Surrey. To be eligible, candidates must live in the geographical area of White Rock and South Surrey, as defined by Elections Canada **and/or** be in full time attendance at one of the following schools: Earl Marriott, Elgin Park, Semiahmoo Secondary, South Surrey/White Rock Learning Centre, White Rock Christian Academy, Panorama Ridge, or Southridge School. Candidates must be continuing their studies at a post-secondary educational institution (academic or vocational).

CRITERIA

- 1. There will be four individual scholarships of \$1500.00 each payable on proof of full time registration at a post-secondary institution.
- 2. The post-secondary program can be either academic or trades training.
- 3. Applicants must be current full time Grade 12 students.
- 4. Applicants must hold a Canadian SIN card.
- 5. The Rotary Club of White Rock is a volunteer service club. As such the Scholarship Committee will consider applicants' demonstrated commitment to volunteer and service activities in the community.
- 6. The committee will also consider the following:
 - a. financial need
 - b. personal references
 - c. scholastic achievement
 - d. future potential and vision of candidates.

To be considered, submissions must:

- 1. Include a Cover letter or Personal outline/essay of up to 500 words, as to why they should be chosen as a recipient.
- 2. Include a completed Community Scholarship Application (attached).
- 3. Include a copy of the applicant's academic transcripts.
- 4. Include one academic/school reference letter and one personal reference letter.
- 5. Be received in electronic format **no later than April 30, 2022** (the sooner, the better) by the Rotary Club of White Rock Scholarship Committee c/o:

Applicants may also include with their submission a short portfolio of not more than five (5) pages, outlining their individual experience, accomplishments and commitment to volunteer and community service.
