Local initiatives

- Canine Assistance Intervention Team Our club has provided Financial Support
 to PADS to provide a Canine Assistance
 Intervention Team. This Team with its key
 member, a specially trained Canine, will assist
 Children at Risk over the foreseeable future.
- Scholarships our club has provided mentorship support to the students at the Learning Center thru the provision of learning opportunities in Rotary programs such as RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Academy) and Adventures in Citizenship opportunities at our National Capital and scholarships for ongoing academic studies.
- DARE an awareness program run by the local RCMP to sensitize children to the negative effects of Drugs and Alcohol.
- Anti-Bullying program funds raised through Fools Night Out are being used to partner with Elementary Schools in White Rock and South Surrey to assist vulnerable children in dealing with Bullying
- Local Food Bank -the Club has now provided two delivery vans to the local 'Sources' Food bank.
- Bryant Park -Rebuilding and seasonal maintenance to provide a pleasant Park setting for local residents

International Projects

 Cambodia Orphanage Support - our Club in partnership with the Rotary Club of Bangkok South, Rotary Club of Minerva, Amsterdam and the FLOAT Foundation are providing monetary support for renovations to an Orphanage housing 35 students in Battambang Cambodia. In addition to funding support for the renovations, our Club has also supported continuing education programs through scholarships for some of the 'graduating' students.



- Books to Guyana Collection and shipment of a container of school books to children in Guyana
- WASRAG-an international project to supply water and sanitary facilities to 14 schools in Africa
- Thailand Hospice Support our Club in partnership with the Rotary Club of Bangkok South raised funds for the construction of an AIDS Hospice just outside Bangkok, Thailand. The new building houses numerous terminally ill men and women.
