DUCK DASH Tickets

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE VERY IMPORTANT RULES!

1. The State Gambling Commission, as always, regulates sales. It can close or cancel the Duck Dash now, and in the future, if errors occur.
2. Only members of the Rotary Club of Arlington, or persons supervised by a member, may sell tickets. No one may be paid to sell tickets.
3. EACH single ticket must be sold for \$5.00. Each discount sheet must be sold for \$20.00. **Do not separate the five stubs from a discount sheet!**
4. Members and their families may purchase tickets, but to avoid embarrassment, we suggest that you do not buy tickets in your name as someone could wrongly conclude the race is “rigged” if a Rotary member is announced as a winner!
5. Turning in your tickets:
 - **YOU MUST USE A DUCK TICKET TALLY SHEET WHEN TURNING IN MONEY AND STUBS.**
 - Prior to July 4, you shall turn in sold ticket stubs with money at our weekly Rotary meetings only. There will be no other location prior to July 4.
 - Please turn in the ticket stubs and money as soon as possible after the sale.
 - All sold ticket stubs with money, and unsold tickets must be turned in **PRIOR TO THE DUCK DASH.**
 - If you have not turned in your unsold tickets or sold ticket stubs by the time of the race, the ducks will be entered in the race and treated if as sold by you. You will be responsible for paying for these tickets.
 - **On July 4th, tickets must be turned in directly to the crew in the Public Works Building at Haller Park.**
6. There is no prohibition to selling to minors.
7. Read and become familiar with the rules on the back of the ticket.
8. **Write your name on the back of each ticket stub so you will get proper credit for the sale**

9. When turning in sold ticket stubs and money, please follow this simple procedure:
 - USE THE DUCK DASH TICKET TALLY SHEET
 - Make sure the ticket calculations match the cash and checks.
 - Provide the ticket tally sheet, sold ticket stubs and money at turn in at our weekly Rotary meeting.
 - More tickets to sell will be available at Arlington Pharmacy, but no sold ticket stubs and money are to be taken to the Pharmacy.
 - Repeat this simple procedure over and over!
10. Our club is required by the Gambling Commission to account for every sold and unsold ticket. You, as a salesman, must also account for every ticket that has been issued to you.
11. If you need to pick up additional tickets, please contact Eric Scott. When you pick-up additional tickets, make sure the information is accurately entered into the log book that accompanies the tickets. **Remember to write your name on back of each discount sheet for tracking purposes.**
12. If one person is buying a \$20 discount sheet...name and contact info only needs to be written on one ticket stub. This info will transfer to all tickets on the sheet. If the purchaser wants to put various names on the 5 tickets, that is OK as well. **Do not separate the 5 ticket stubs!**
