

Dues Effective July 1, 2021 (amended 9-8-21)

Dues need to be adjusted to reflect the following: District dues for 2021-2022 are \$40.00 per year per member, payable to the District in July. The R.I. dues for 2021-2022 are \$69.00 per year per member. There is also a small amount due to R.I. each year that is paid by the club operating account.

Regular Active Member: \$460 semiannually.

(\$40.00 Dist. Dues/\$69.00 R.I. Dues/\$661.50 for 49 lunches/\$70.00 for 2 banquets/\$79.50 Admin Fee = \$920.00 divided by 2 = \$460.00 semiannually)

Active Rule of 85:*** Primary - \$150 semiannually

(\$40.00 Dist. Dues/\$69.00 R.I. Dues/ \$191.00 Admin. Fee = \$300.00 divided by 2 = \$150.00 semiannually)

Active Member-at-large:*** Primary - \$150 semiannually

Rotaract Member: Secondary – Pay for meal only.

Initiation Fee: A new member is charged an initiation fee of \$75, payable before the new member is inducted.

Meals: For those members who qualify for paying for meals separately, and for guests, the charge for the regular meeting lunch shall be \$15. This will not include a Split the Pot ticket.

Complimentary Meals: There will be no charge for guests that fall into the following categories:

- Prospective members once formally proposed for membership.
- Speakers and program guests.
- Up to 2 family members attending a new member's induction ceremony.
- Students being recognized along with their family and accompanying school staff member(s).
- District officers if conducting official business, e.g. the District Governor's visitation & Assistant Governor's visits.

Business Expense. We do not have a business membership. The member is invoiced individually for dues and the member is liable for the payment of dues even if the member's employer/business pays the bill on behalf of the member. We will not invoice the employer/business directly. Even if dues are paid by the member's employer/business, termination of employment does not relieve the member from liability for dues. A member is liable for all dues up to the time a member resigns, or membership is otherwise terminated.

Spouses/Partners. When spouses or domestic partners have designated one to be a member-at-large, the member-at-large shall not be required to pay for a meal unless both are present for the meal.

*** A member who qualifies for the Rule of 85, or as a member-at-large, may elect with the treasurer to pay for meals in advance at the same rate as a regular active member.
