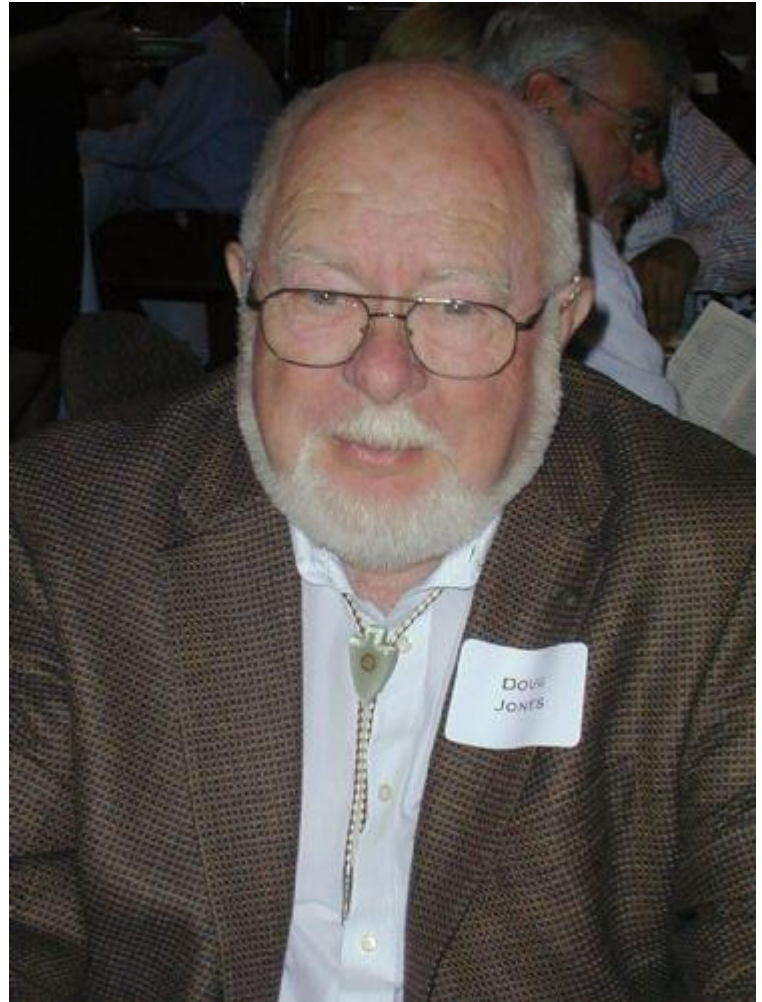

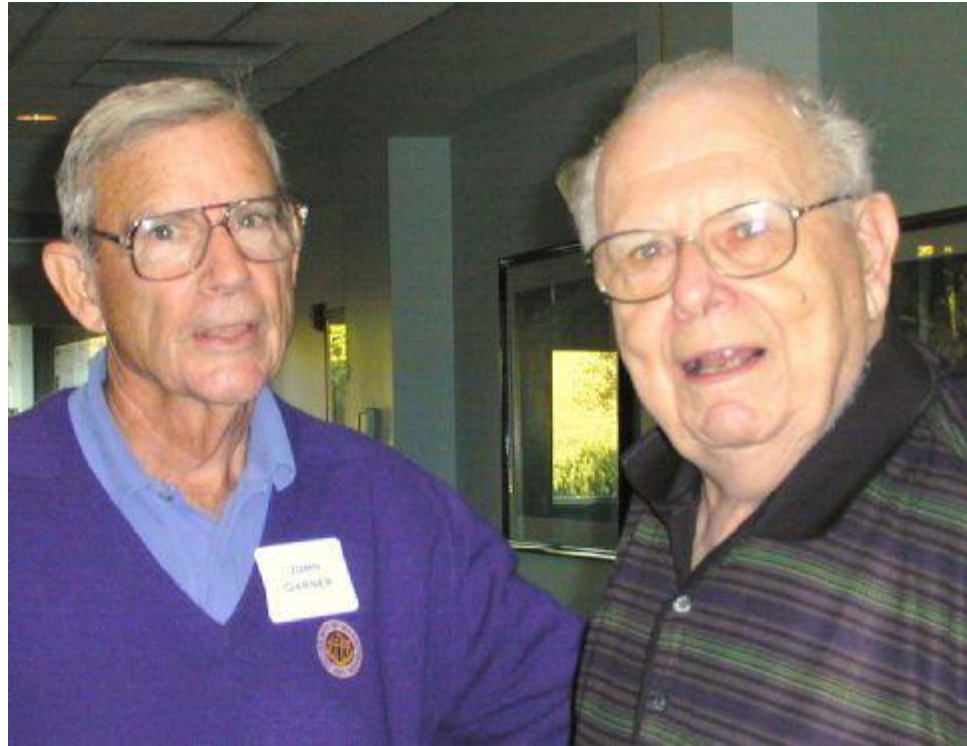

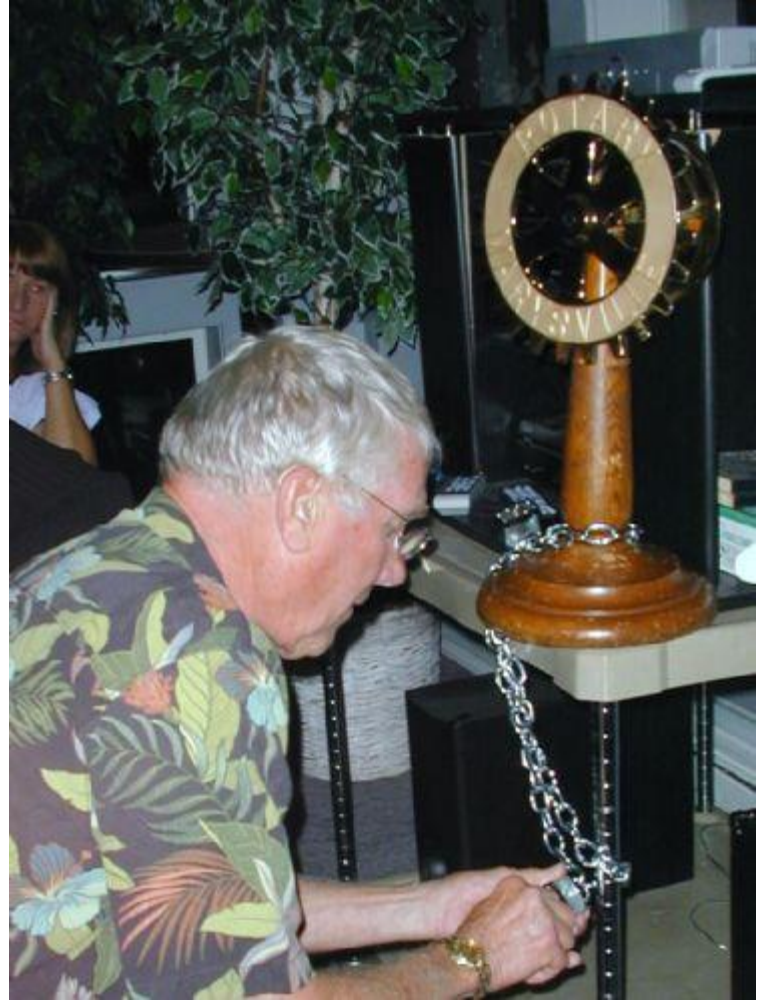
Harv helped with one of our hands on projects, building camping shelters at the Fire M Camp, organized by Venne Beauchamp, a member of our club and a Marysville contractor.
