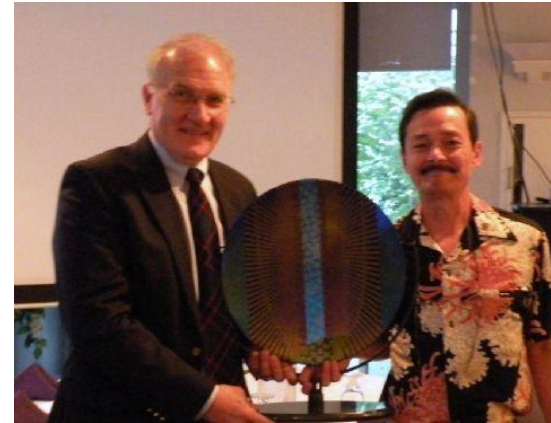

Club Runner and Spouses

As webmaster I have had to decide how to handle spouses. When both spouses are in our club both are registered as members. Spouses who are not members of our club can be handled either as "other users" or as "friends". As other users a spouse gets a notice that a member would get. This means when he/she gets an email about attending or declining an event, he/she must respond separately to keep the count accurate, just as would each member.

To see how you are being handled or you just want to see who is attending, declining or undecided, go to the event registration and click on the "attend or decline" and when it takes you to the next screen there is a line above the comment section that says see who has registered. Click on that and see how you are being handled.

If your spouse doesn't get a separate invite then you need to register him/her as your guest. That will give us a good count. Your spouse's status as an "other user" or as a "guest" can be changed. Just let me know you want a change and then let me know.

Remember that if you just reply to the event invitation it will come to the member who generated the invite and not to the chair of the event nor will it register you for the event. Also if you just tell us about someone coming as a guest in the comments, the guest doesn't get registered.

Registering or declining an invite has the additional advantage to me of knowing you are able to log onto the web site. Those who have not responded may not be able to log on. If that is the case hit reply and tell me your problem and I can help.
