The Rotary Club of Bellingham Foundation Provides \$90,500 in Scholarships

BELLINGHAM, WA 3/3/22 — The Rotary Club of Bellingham Foundation has provided \$90,500 in scholarships to local, deserving students this school year.

The Foundation allotted \$68,000 to provide for scholarships through the local Whatcom Dollars for Scholars program. The Foundation provides Whatcom Dollars for Scholars criteria for these scholarships, some of which are named for Rotarians. These accounted for a total of 16 scholarships, ten of which are one-time scholarships and the other six are renewable.

Additional scholarship funds are provided to the Bellingham Technical College Foundation for named scholarships with specific criteria.

The Rotary Club of Bellingham Foundation, a 501(c)3, receives Club member donations as well as donations from the community. The Foundation, founded in 1998, got its start when the Club raffled off a Volkswagen Convertible. It was won by Member Bob Gibb, who immediately gave it back to the Club which sold it, providing the first significant funds. Other Rotarians also provided endowments for separate scholarships. The Foundation has had two other major fundraising efforts. Over ten years ago Rotarian D.C. Morse spearheaded and personally contacted members and raised over \$270,000 to endow the Club's scholarships and in 2017, as a Club, just over \$997,000 was raised by members. The fund really started to grow with those efforts and today, the Foundation has over \$1.8 million for scholarships and Club service projects.

The Rotary Club of Bellingham also recognizes student achievement and leadership through their Student of the Month program and Youth Adventures in Leadership (Y.A.I.L.).
