The following prizes will be awarded to **the top three students** in each category:

A draw will be held for a \$50 Best Buy Gift Certificate after each event for all contestants and children in attendance at the Spelling Bee. The student must be in attendance at the time of the draw to win the Gift Certificate. We will also be drawing for a \$100 Indigo gift certificate for the teachers in attendance at the Spelling Bee!

Schools that register their students directly in the Spelling Bee will be eligible to win The Rotary Club of Ancaster Am Literacy Bursary of \$1,000 to be drawn at the Spelling Bee. To be eligible for the Bursary, a teacher from the school must register the students for the Spelling Bee by contacting Kathryn Smith at kathryns@mbspc.ca directly.

Each elementary school in Hamilton Wentworth District School boards and Home Schools are invited to enter three students in each category. (Grades 4-6 and Grades 7-8.) Please note that the Spelling Bee registration will be on a first to register basis and will be limited to the first 50 students in each category. Please complete the attached form for the students that are being entered from your school and return to us no later than Friday June 7, 2024.

The Spelling Bee will be held at the Rotary Centre in Ancaster. Parking will be free for the day. The competition for Grades 4 through 6 will begin at 9:00 am and students are asked to report to the registration desk by 8:45 am. The competition for Grades 7&8 will commence at 1:00 pm and students are asked to report to the registration desk by 12:45pm.
