The Paul Harris Fellow recognition acknowledges individuals who contribute, or who have contributions made in their name, of US\$1,000 to The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International.

At the Club level

- Dundas Valley Sunrise Rotary Club has given Paul Harris Fellowship Awards since its first year as a chartered club.
- Awards given to both members and [non-Rotarian] individuals in the community.
- Members are asked to nominate people for the award.

At the Club level ... continued

- The administration of this is part of the role of the Past-President who is also chair of the Rotary Foundation Committee in the club.
- Recognition should be given "at an appropriate occasion which dignifies the significance of the award".
- The club has a portion of its budget (20%) allocated for The Rotary Foundation

At the Club level ... continued

- The club has a "bank" of recognition points that it can draw upon to give awards in any given year.
- Club members regularly make donations to the Rotary Foundation adding to the budgeted amount.

For the Member

- Members can receive a Paul Harris Recognition
- Members can also contribute \$1000 to the Rotary Foundation and receive an award.
- Members can "upgrade" their awards with regular contributions to the Rotary Foundation.
- Contributions can also be used by the member to GIVE an award to an individual ..."recognition points"

For the Member continued

- All club members are encouraged to give some amount to the Rotary Foundation (EREY)
- a member's history of giving is available at any time on "My Rotary" on the Rotary International website.
- the recognition is a pin and certificate (1st one) and then "upgrades" to the pin for subsequent recognition

At the Rotary International Level

- Donations "released" after three years
- Half of a District's contributions to the Annual Fund are returned to the District for use in international programs
- Major Donor
- Paul Harris Society
- Arch Klumpf Society

At the Rotary International Level

- almost 100% of donations reach programs
- Rotary International Foundation is separate from Rotary International
- various funds annual, PolioPlus ...
- areas of focus for \$\$\$ established by trustees with member input

- Promoting peace
- Fighting disease
- Providing clean water, sanitation and hygiene
- Saving mothers and children
- Supporting education
- Growing local economies
