Guest Speakers: Hugh and Annie

Hugh started with a historic perspective. The auction has been going on for over 40 years. When Hugh first joined Fonthill, about 20 years ago, he made it a priority to get our club to work with Welland again. We added Port Colborne and Fort Erie and had the first weekend of December as our auction. 14 years ago, Cogeco could no longer sustain the three weekends. They asked us to figure out how to do the Auction on one weekend with 7 clubs. Thus began the MEGA Rotary TV Auction. This year is our 14th one and after the first teo years, Hugh became, and still is, chair of the Steering Committee that has representation from each club. Hugh shared that he still has reluctance to make the 'ask.' On the other hand this is the FIRST year he has already sent out his 'asks' and received some replies!

Annie had a slide presentation of the process for canvassers to follow. I'm just going to have some bullet points in chronological order.

- Auction Chair Hugh. Canvass Chair Annie. Opportunities for doing more than canvassing. More later. We NEED everyone to canvass. AND enter on Wizard see Annie if that's a concern.
- Last year we brought in \$16,316 net with items valued at \$24,130. 2022 Goal is \$25,000 net. One way to do this is increase calue of donated items to \$35K and get 65% of last year's value.
- Let's expand our donor base! Let's have fun doing it!
- Let donors know where our proceeds get allocated. (Paul bringing our newest cards so you have on hand)
- Most important dates for Canvassers October 14 is cutoff for donation commitments- don't
 worry if item not in hand or entered. Still have a week! October 21 wizard closes to members so
 there's that week in between for admin to finish entering items.

- Instructions for writing a good script (needed details) and tabloid description (title) You get maximum return for having everything in your blurb that they recommend.
- Every donation must have value of \$50 or more
- Only cash donation eligible for charitable receipt.
- If someone says they've already given, just say Thanks for helping Rotary.
- Once you've entered on Wizard, you can print off two copies for an item and one copy for a gift certificate
