Today's Presentation Marty Misener, Shaver Hotel Dieu Foundation. Marty is the Senior Development Officer of their Foundation. Also here with Marty is Kristina Manzi, the Executive Director of the Foundation since 2018. She is from the health care field and loves gardening. Introducing all three is David Ceglie, Current CEO with 20 years' experience and father of younger boys.

Marty started with the Shaver being the only rehab hospital in Niagara. There are 400 residents. Vision, Inspiration, Renewing Lives, Visionaries in Rehabilitation and Compassionate Care – the motto! Marty added that Mental Health is included. His and staff's job is to give lives back. The greatest asset is the Interdisciplinary Team.

Since 2016, we've sustained the highest level of satisfaction.

People can stay home longer with rehabilitation. Stats last year – 1200 inpatients and 25,687 outpatients. 134 patient beds: High 37, low intensity 80 beds, short term 12 beds, end of life 5 beds.

Main diagnoses: Stroke, ALS, MS, Spinal Cord. Outpatients – rehab. Stroke Rehab Excellence – received highest award. Happy to take club or individual on tour! Specialty programs. Rankin Family Cancer Rehabilitation, Parkinson's Rehab Program.

Raise funds. Annual letters and Communication. Service Clubs and Grants. Staff growing. Where do the funds go? 42 beds and specialty mattresses, Patient lifts (\$55,000)

What's next? Expansion Program

David. We work with Ministries. In 2000, we were talking about it. In 2017, the ministry gave \$2000 to look at it. The Plan is ready to submit in March. Then, design and build – 2023-2033 finish. Spade in ground.

Beds. 134 presently and we'll go to 196. We have an aging population -3^{rd} highest in Canada. There are services to keep people at home. 120 LTC patients taken. 1/3 didn't have to go into LTC, they went home. It's a 20 year plan.

Paul. Do you use students? **Marty** Students in the Nursing and Medical program. If experienced in Occupational Training, etc., we'd take their students.

Project costs? | today, \$600Million total. We're responsible for 10%, Hopefully it's coming out over the summer. All will be single rooms. Satisfaction rate must be because of high Satisfaction of staff. We've embraced 'serving' opportunities to progress people's careers. There is a high trust with the teams. Leadership approach is ideas come from the staff. WE have an annual barbeque/ People feel recognised.
