Frank. Perhaps with our PODS setup, a **POD leader** from each of our three PODS could be on the membership committee for 3 years.

LN Information is important as Bob has noted.

Goals are helpful to new and ongoing members.

It's recommended that the Strategic Plan be reviewed every 3 years.
