- All applications must be endorsed by two members of that Rotary club, one of which is the Club President.
- All applications must be submitted to the District Scholarship Chair by December 31, 2017.
- Only complete applications will be considered. (Follow the check list)
- The scholarship committee will evaluate all qualifying applications based on the following criteria:
  - o academic merit;
  - o a demonstration of "Service Above Self"; and
  - o an essay about the ideals of Rotary
- The successful applicant will be notified by January 31, 2018.

#### WHAT CAN THE SCHOLARSHIP BE USED FOR

- The scholarship is open to any area of study.
- The scholarship must be used towards full time post-secondary study at a University, College, or Community College anywhere in the world.

- The student must be enrolled in full time post-secondary study at a University, College, or Community College anywhere in the world.
