Please note that the following proposed membership classes shall:

- (a) not vote*;
- (b) not hold any club office;
- (c) not hold classifications; and
- (d) be entitled to attend all meetings and enjoy all other privileges in the club, but have no rights or privileges in any other club, except to visit without being a Rotarian's guest.

Spousal Membership:

- Only spouses of current members are eligible (this includes common-law spouses).
- The spouse must join one of the club's committees.
- The spouse must attend 40% of the annual meetings or make up a meeting by attending a committee meeting or volunteering at a club event/fundraiser.
- The spouse will be a member of the Rotary Club of Niagara Falls Sunrise.
- Spouse's club dues will be \$100.

Associate (Introductory Member):

- This classification of membership will last no longer than 18 months.
- The intentions are to introduce a potential member to our club and the joys of Rotary. An 18 month membership will ensure they set good habits regarding attendance, and ensure they have the time to attend an RLI session.
- Associate members must attend 50% of the annual meetings or make up a meeting by attending a committee meeting or volunteering at a club event/fundraiser.
- The Associate members must sit on a committee.
- The Associate must attend a RLI session (covered in their dues cost), and present to the club their findings.
- The associate member will be a member of the Rotary Club of Niagara Falls Sunrise.
- Associate Membership dues will be: \$150 for 18 months. (\$75 going to RLI).

Corporate Membership:

- The corporation will register one employee with RI and pay full RI/District dues.
- The corporation may have up to two other representatives attend meetings as members of our club.
- There must always be an employee of the corporation at one of our meetings.
- Corporate members will have sponsor advertising at all of the club's events (RibFest, Paul Harris Evening) - this helps them justify the ability to deduct this membership as an advertising expense for tax purposes.
- Cost for a Corporate Membership is \$1000.
