This is a home that celebrates art, originality, and family. Their stunning property reaches back into nature, with tall evergreens and a lush green meadow that is home to a perfectly adorable bunkie, and a pool that rivals Versailles with its elegant symmetry. The pleasing nature of design is echoed throughout this eclectic home, seen in the astonishingly original decor and furniture pieces that have been reclaimed, repurposed, and reused. Many are family heirlooms, such as the bowfront vintage curio cabinet, or the beautifully preserved pine fireplace, or the 200-year-old Harvest table planks, artfully repurposed and reused throughout the home. But it is their collection of art, celebrating international, Canadian, and local artists, as well as their own family photo galleries, that lend such personality to this home.

Gauld Nurseries and **Joanne Young**, Garden Coach, have teamed up with decorator, **Elaine Bartolini**, to bring this country home to life. The living and dining rooms are adorned with an abundance of pinecones, scented greens, cherished heirloom crystal and china. The great room is filled with handmade ornaments, twinkling curly willow and cascading greenery.

BlueGate 210 CENTRE ST, NOTL

BlueGate is an 'upside-down' house with the living space on the ground floor and the sleeping quarters below. It was their Mennonite builder's design that allowed the owners to create 'a house of windows' with soaring dormered ceilings, 9-foot doorways and an 18-foot, hand-cut stone fireplace. The unique layout of the kitchen comes from the chef – in the family's wish to cook without getting in anyone's way. 'Joe's room' is the result – a perfectly curated cooking space with everything he needs right at his fingertips. In 2017, BlueGate was awarded 'Best Compatible Design' for the new home that best fits into its historic surroundings.

Joe Carlino has worked with some of the world's most cutting-edge luxury retail icons – Neiman Marcus, Saks, and Holt Renfrew, to name a few. From the outdoorstyle of LA to the Mies van der Rohe influence of his Chicago home, these brands have helped to form the unique style Joe is known for today – the culmination of a life well lived.

Lakeview 346 QUEEN ST, NOTL PRESENTED BY: 124 ON QUEEN HOTEL AND SPA

This home has a quiet and splendid presence amid the surrounding streetscape overlooking Lake Ontario. The landscaping work is key because the owners feel the exterior conveys just as much as the interior. Once inside, a display of traditional and modern characterizes this 30-year-old home, with its superb cascading staircase, vaulted ceilings, and open entertaining-style kitchen. And then it wraps around you with a canopied courtyard, creating a perfect oasis. Termed a 'Florida' design, the oasis features a pool, a three-season cabana, and a woodburning fireplace, surrounded by 30-year-old trees. But perhaps the anchor to this home is a portrait of the owner's great grandmother, painted by well-known Canadian artist, George Reid, who gave it to her in exchange for lodgings in 1880. It truly reflects the love in this home.

Somerset 111 FRONT ST, NOTL PRESENTED BY: SHAW FESTIVAL THEATRE

Somerset is situated on the original site of the Queen's Royal Hotel, built in 1868, and known as one of the most fabulous hotels in North America. The hotel attracted wealthy tourists from Canada, United States and abroad, and was the site of many social gatherings, international sporting events, and luxurious recreation. The Queen's Royal Hotel was demolished in 1930 when tourism in the area declined. In 1988, the site was purchased by the previous owners of the Prince of Wales Hotel, to host their most premier guests, and after selling the hotel in 2000, the house remained in the family. Recently renovated, Somerset has three deluxe guest suites, each with private terraces that enjoy spectacular views of Lake Ontario, the United States and Toronto. Continuing the tradition of exquisite accommodation, Somerset has become the beautiful residence you see today.


Riverview 293 RICARDO ST, NOTL

The Parish was established in 1827. In 1834, the Roman Catholic community built a clapboard church on land granted by the Crown. The present day church is on the original site. All future renovations remained consistent with the original Gothic Revival style. The large addition, constructed in 1964, preserved most of the older section of the church with the choir loft serving as a bridge between the old and new. St. Vincent de Paul is one of the oldest Catholic churches in the Province of Ontario.



ANNUAL SITE NOTL: DECORATED BY THE GARDEN CLUB OF NIAGARA McFarland House 15927 NIAGARA PARKWAY

The Garden Club of Niagara will decorate both the inside and outside of McFarland House in the theme, 'Holiday Stories'. The club uses authentic natural materials for designs and decorations suitable to the period of the home.

This historic Georgian manor home was built by John McFarland and his sons. Descendants of the McFarlands lived in the house for over 140 years before it was restored by The Niagara Parks Commission and opened to the public in 1959. During the War of 1812, both British and American forces used the home as a hospital, and in 1813, the British attack on Fort Niagara was



launched from the ravine on the property. McFarland House is one of the only structures to survive the burning of the town when occupying American forces retreated from the area, making it one of the oldest properties in Niagara-on-the-Lake. Today, McFarland House portrays early nineteenth century life in Upper Canada. There will be sticky toffee pudding, scones, homemade hot chocolate, mulled cider, and tea. www.mcfarlandhouse.com

ANNUAL SITE QUEENSTON: DECORATED BY MULLEN GARDEN MARKET RiverBrink Art Museum 116 QUEENSTON ST

RiverBrink Art Museum is home to historical artworks created by Canadian, American, and European artists from the collection of the late Samuel E. Weir. Artworks by many of Canada's most celebrated artists, including Tom Thomson and members of the Group of Seven, are on display.

During the Holiday House Tour 2024, RiverBrink is showcasing the collection in exhibitions Centre and Periphery: The Group of Seven; Borderland; and Artists on Tour.



This year, Mullen Garden Market brings a festive touch to the art museum with amazing holiday displays and decorations. Visitors are welcome to explore the Holiday Market and RiverBrink Cift Shop, which features local artwork for purchase, as well as the beautiful grounds overlooking the Niagara River opposite Lewiston, NY.



ANNUAL SITE QUEENSTON: DECORATED BY GARDEN CLUB OF NIAGARA Willowbank Estate 14487 NIAGARA RIVER PKWY, QUEENSTON




Built in 1834 as a private residence for Alexander Hamilton, his wife and their 11 children. Willowbank is now a national historic site of Canada and home to the School of Restoration Arts. In 2001, its future was jeopardized when its owner threatened to demolish the home if his request to build a subdivision on the property was not approved. Thanks to the intervention of a group of concerned neighbours, Willowbank was saved. Since 2006, the revered School of Restoration Arts has trained the heritage conservators of tomorrow at the Estate, whereby students learn heritage conservation methods through theory and applied learning. Local folklore has it that Alexander's wife, Hannah, can sometimes be glimpsed peering out a second-floor window as she continues to watch over her beloved home. www.willowbank.ca

He is buried at St. Mark's Cemetery in Niagara-on-the-Lake.
