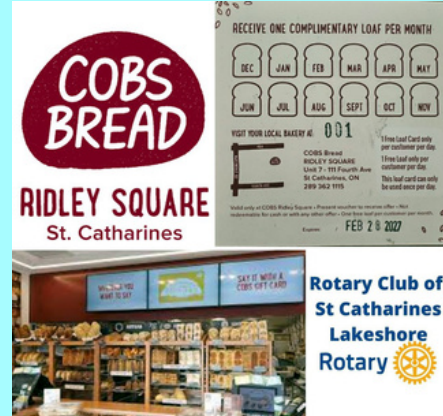

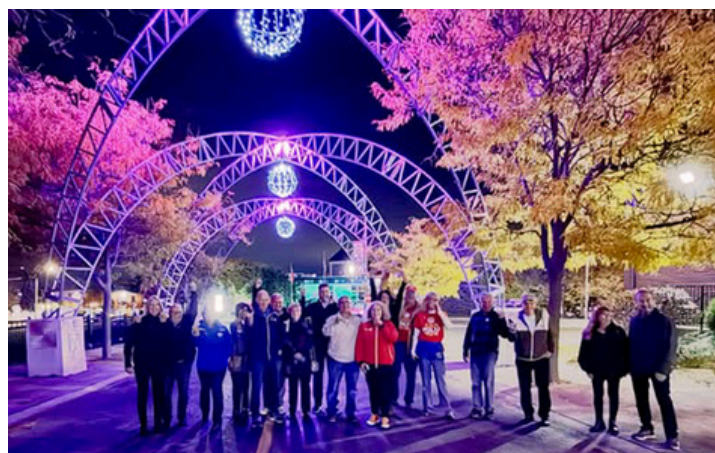

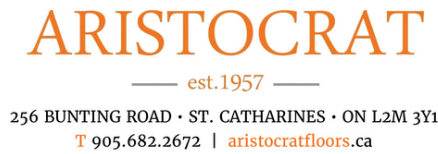
Thanks to everyone's generosity, approximately 400 children will receive the polio vaccine – giving them the gift of a healthy, polio-free future.
