Club Loses Gino Marchionda

(March 5, 1933 – July 16, 2023)

We are very sad to announce that Gino Marchionda, age 90, passed away on July 16, 2023.

Gino joined the Rotary Club of St. Catharines Lakeshore on November 12 2009, remaining a member until December 31, 2022 when he was forced to resign due to ill health. In March 2013, he was honoured with a Paul Harris by the Club in recognition of his service.

Gino was a passionate supporter of all of our Fundraising activities, allowing his business Manor Cleaners to be the site of cash Lobsterfest, Trivia Night, Evening in Paris ticket sales and pick-ups - with promotional signs for every event plastered over his front lobby where all his many customers could see them. Whenever asked to be a cash sponsor for an event, his only question was always "How much do you need?"

He also enthusiastically supported many of our Club's hospital-related fundraising and donation events. His dry cleaning discount coupon book efforts in support of the hospital Walker Family Cancer Centre were legendary (raising \$10's of thousands of dollars) and his Niagara Clean and Healthy Cycling Team (with daughters Annette and Gina) raised over \$225,000 in support of the Centre.

Perhaps more than anything else, Gino will be remembered for sharing a laugh through his truly epic Happy Dollars.
