

Our Nepal Project Wins Niagara Cluster Fund Support!

On October 28th, the Rotary Club of St. Catharines's Bhangre Jhayaure Water Supply & Sanitation Project won the Niagara Cluster Fund support. With matching from District 7090 and RI this raises \$28,000 USD of the \$65,000 needed for this global grant project. An international water project was part of the club's strategic plan and it is exciting to see it come to fruition.

Bhangre Jhayaure village is located at Bardibas Municipality, Mahattori District, and Province-2 of Nepal. Located in a remote part of the municipality (takes three hours to access), people of this tiny village do not have access to clean drinking water. Villagers of Bhangre Jhayaure have to walk 1-2 hours (3.7km) every day to access water from a river which is not properly filtered causing many water borne illnesses within the population. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), between 50 and 100 litres of water per person per day is needed to ensure the most basic needs are met but these villagers are only getting around 7-11 liters of water which needs to be used for drinking, bathing, washing the clothes/dishes, and for the cattle, the source of their livelihood.

As the international partner, the Rotary Club of St. Catharines Lakeshore is joining forces with the host club, the Rotary Club of Dhulikhel. The project consist of installing a water filtration and holding system and laying pipes to transport water from the river to the village. A tap will be installed at each village hut with a nominal fee of one USD charged monthly to access the water. The Rotary Club of Dhulikhel, spearheaded by Ranjeev Shrestha, is currently putting together a committee to oversee the building of the water filtration system and the ongoing maintenance and sustainability of the project. They are in the process of completing the formal needs assessment report required for the global grant along with drafting the global grant application. They are also selecting the companies needed for the project and putting together a documentary to be used for fundraising.

We are excited to partner with the Rotary Club of Dhilkhel and helping them anyway we can while getting to know the club members better included setting up a joint zoom call!

\$1500 Donated to Happy Rolph's Accessible Playground


