Club Donates for Linhaven Resident Care Equipment



President Coral and Committee Chair Bruce were pleased to present a \$1,500 donation to Linhaven Long Term Care Program manager Heather Wild for resident care equipment. The cheque was presented in the existing building lobby's "Town Square". They hope to move into the new building under construction - a five-storey, noncombustible structure that will include 256 long-term care beds and have direct access to a new Seniors Community Hub - early in 2025.

Cape Floral Kingdom Project Update

Early in the 2024 Rotary year, the Club donated to a Global Grant to support the Sugarbird Project –which trains, equips and manages small teams of invasive alien plant warriors on Table Mountain National Park in South Africa. The these teams protect the Cape Floral Kingdom, comprising mostly fynbos as the predominant plant species, the smallest of the world's six floral kingdoms, and the only one contained within the borders of a single country, South Africa. It has the highest concentration of plant species and is a UNESCO world heritage site.

In a recent report from the lead Waterfront Rotary Club, significant progress was reported, primarily in the Devils Peak site. There has been new emphasis on clearing bottle brush. It is hard to eradicate as it has an extensive root system and they have to be dug up. The Devils Peak area was divided into numbered sections. Several areas have been successfully cleared of alien vegetation. The team was very pleased to see indigenous flowers coming back where the smothering alien vegetation had been cleared.
