Food4Kids Update Collaborative Grant Schedule Begins in September!

The District's first Collaborative Grant, involving collaboration with Niagara-on-the-Lake, Welland, St Catharines South, St Catharines, and Niagara Rotaract clubs launches in September. \$10,500 US pledged by the Clubs has been matched by the District for a total of \$21,000 US. Food will be ordered mid to end Sept. and we will begin packing again in October.

Tentative packing dates for this Rotary year are Oct 5. Nov 2, Dec 7, Jan 18, Feb 15, Mar 29, April 26, May 3 and June 7.

Some of our packing dates will be considered part of our District Collaborative Grant requirement.

NOTE: A grocery store food drive has been scheduled for Sept 23 from 1-5 at the two St Catharines NOFRILLS stores. Volunteers will be needed to man the table and collected food outside each store, drivers to take food to the Food4kids office throughout the afternoon and at the end of the food drive, and people at the office to help unload the contributions.

Clarice West-Hobbs Contemplative Garden Update Drip Irrigation System Installed!

An *"emergency drip irrigation system"* was included within the original Phase 1 Plan for periods of heavy drought, as St. Catharines has experienced over the 90+ days since the Garden was planted.

The new drip irrigation system, partially funded by a matching \$2000 US Grant from Rotary District 7090, has been installed by Rain Your Way Lawn Sprinklers of Wainfleet. The system will allow the entire 1725 sq. ft. (160 sq. m.) of the seven Phase 1 garden bed areas to be watered as needed in a more efficient and conservative fashion.

Thanks also to the "Watering Team" for keeping things alive while we waited for the installation and to everyone who participated in our recent Weeding and Mulching Party! **Snow White** (*male version as my hair has turned white*) and his many dwarves could only describe the volunteers as we crossed the street from Mr. Mike's parking lot to the hospital site.
