Text of the Grand Opening Remarks by Garden Chair

For those unable to attend, here is the text of Clarice West Hobbs Garden Chair Eric Jones' remarks from the Grand Opening Ceremony.

I would like to give you a bit of background on Clarice and how the Garden came to be. Many of you here knew Clarice but you may not be aware of all she accomplished in her life: Here is a quick re-cap:

- Worked as an educator in various provinces and countries, including Scotland, for over 30 years finally for the District School Board of Niagara.
- Led the Lincoln Women's Teacher Association, winning their humanitarian award.
- Was on the governing board of the Ontario College of Teachers.
- Following retirement, was very active with Retired Teachers of Ontario (RTO), Retired Women Teachers of Ontario, and Canadian Association for Retired Persons (CARP).
- Chair of the Mayor's Advisory Committee for Seniors.
- Member of Steering Committee and Volunteer Chair for the Ontario Senior Games 2004.
- Member of the Y.M.C.A. Board of Directors
- Member of the Welland Canal Parkway Task Force.
- Long-time member of the Rotary Club of St. Catharines Lakeshore (over 20 years) and Chair of the World & Community Service Committee.
- Twice recognized as Paul Harris Award Winner, the highest honour a Rotary Club can bestow for outstanding service to the Community.



It was Clarice's dream to have a Garden at the St. Catharines hospital – like the one she saw in Niagara Falls while she was a patient there.With her untimely passing in 2020, the Club decided to support her dream by developing The Clarice West-Hobbs Contemplative Garden. The site is far from the high traffic entrance and parking but is on the walkway, heavily used by patients, visitors and staff alike.

Over two phases covering 2021 and 2022, the Club created the Garden you now see along the western side of the hospital. The plan by Gauld Nurseries emphasized drought and salt resistant, yet colourful, hardy perennials and bushes all supported by a drip irrigation system. The Garden was also designed to take advantage of the existing sidewalks, lights, trees and most importantly, enhance the etched Labyrinth used by Mental Health for their patients. The Club has added six unique Sitting Rocks, installed by Landscapes by Bill Nieuwenhuyzen, to augment the benches.
