**Award is Open to:** Applicants must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and enrolled, or intend to enroll, in a full-time undergraduate program as per the above description. Student must have an appropriate average to demonstrate academic achievement.

## **Eligibility for Application:**

- Attending a Norfolk County High School.
- Entering a recognized post secondary institution with intent to study in interdiscipline fine arts as per the description above.
- Admission to a recognized College or University as a full-time student for the upcoming Fall semester.

#### How to Apply:

The application, as per Schedule A should include:

- A. Compact disc/digital images of 10 works in any medium, created within the last two years, properly labelled (with media, date title).
- B. An essay of no more than 500 words describing:
  - 1) applicant's art/design work;
  - 2) applicant's future plans;
  - 3) why the applicant needs this scholarship; and
  - 4) why the applicant is the best candidate for the scholarship.

#### References:

Two letters of recommendation as per Schedule B of the Application from teachers, counsellor, community/church leader. One of the two letters should be from an art teacher or mentor familiar with the applicant's work who can comment on the student's developing art skills.

After review of completed application by the Watts Scholarship committee, all students will be notified by mail or e-mail of the final decision.

#### Deadline:

Completed electronic and paper applications must be received by May 15th.
