The scholarship is currently up to \$3200 per student which is paid out in four \$800 increments, one for each year the student remains in college and maintains a 2.5 GPA.

Eligibility: The scholarship is open to graduates who reside within the Le Roy Central School District, regardless of the district from which they graduate.
