**Purpose:**

To help further the education of deserving young men and women who display the qualities inherent to Rotarians through scholarship awards. The OPRF Scholarship will be awarded to students who display the qualities of a Rotarian through their schoolwork, occupational work, community involvement, school involvement and social interactions.

**Grant:**

\$5000 to be paid over four years divided by the number of recipients
