Harry Kim touched again on the wonderful arrangements for the Golf Tournament on June 26th.

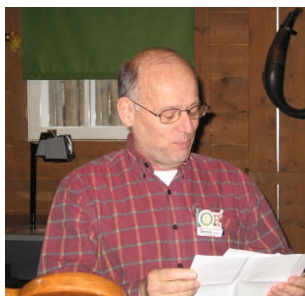
