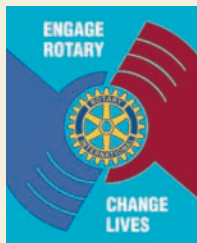

ACCIDENT RE-CONSTRUCTION - HUGH STIRLING

Hugh started his presentation by stating that Dennis Tillotson warned him to be amusing not his normal serious self.
