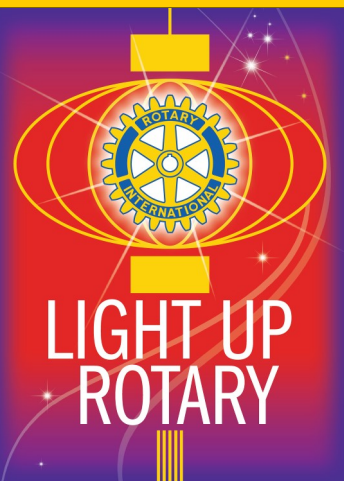
Meeting notes:
