Background: Due to COVID-19 access by Victory Outreach to the Calgary Food Bank and the Food Link program has been disrupted and it is uncertain when that will end. Residents provide their own meals on weekends and breakfast and lunch on weekdays. Food Link was used to subsidize very low-income residents. \$400 per week would feed 59 residents’ dinner once a day during the week in a communal meal setting which is the most efficient way in which to use supporting funds.

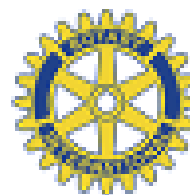
