Guatemala is a very poor country and the governments response is not enough particularly outside of major towns. This food bag program is intended specifically for people who have lost their income because of COVID-19. The Los Altos Rotary Club with their local connections are able to assess the requests and direct the food bags to where they are most needed.

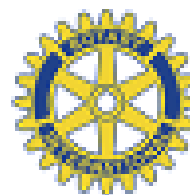
