Program:

President Christine introduced the speakers for the program on Rotary giving.

Don McArthur, on The Rotary Foundation

Jim Davis, on The Calgary Rotary Clubs Foundation

And Brad Wellicome, leading the Club Fundraising committee.

This is followed by an interview with Kathy Le.

Don McArthur talked about The Rotary Foundation. (TRF)

Annual Fund: 50% of this amount returns to the district 3 years later and can be accessed by Clubs as District grants. (District Designated Funds or DDF) The other 50% is used for international service and can be accessed as global grants.

Donations to TRF may be designated to the Polio Fund. In that case 100% will be used to eradicate Polio.

Administration cost is low. Only 8% of the funds donated is used for administration.

Through the Endowment Fund TRF supports Rotary Peace fellowships etc.

Donations to TRF is tax deductible.

How can you donate?

\$100 per year – Sustaining Member

\$1000 Paul Harris Fellow

First time Donors, this Rotary Year will have their donation matched up to 500 points.

Sustaining donors will be matched to 100 points

Jim Davis talked about the Calgary Rotary Clubs Foundation. (CRCF)

Formed in 1972, it has over \$55 million in assets.

All 12 Calgary Rotary Clubs are voting members.

5% of the 3 yr average of invested capital is allocated to the club.

In the year 2020 Our allocation is \$2628.0

Administrative cost is low. The Board and governance work at no cost

How can you donate?

Cash Stock options Bequests Life Insurance RSP/RIF Real estate.

Donations in 2020 of \$50 and up will be matched by the President to a Max of \$500.

Brad Wellicome talked about The Heritage Park Rotary Club of Calgary Fund (HPRCCF)

This was formed in March 2020 with partnership with the Calgary Foundation.

Tax donations will be issued for amounts of \$25 or more. 1% is the cost of administration.

This is useful for members to donate for events, like the Golf Tournament, and receive a tax receipt.

Kathy Le facilitated some good questions to clarify some points.
