HAPPY BUCKS: The group seemed to be in a somewhat sombre mood this morning and as a result there was no contribution in this regard.

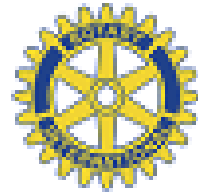
