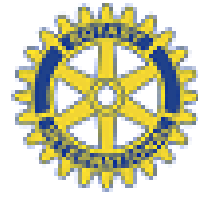
President Christine gave a big thanks for all those who helped with the Community Kitchen and 5 for her grandfather that was blind,
