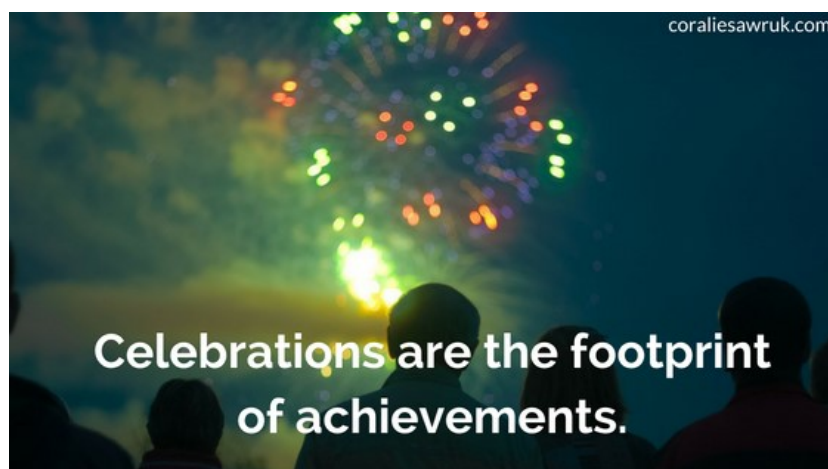
Sheriff - Ginny this week
