Brief Overview of the Rules for RCRC Hockey Pool 2023–2024

- 1) The contest is open to Residents of British Columbia 19 years of age and above only.
- 2) A total of 500 numbered hockey draft forms will be available at a cost of \$20/each
- 3) Sales will end at 4:00 PM (PDT) on Monday, October 9, 2023.
- 4) The contest will conclude at the end of the NHL season on Thursday April 18, 2024.
- 5) All hockey draft forms will be consecutively numbered.
- 6) Each of the Hockey draft forms provided by HockeyDraft.ca (copy attached) will have the contestants name, email address, telephone number and seller’s name. Please print clearly. Once completed return to the Royal City Rotary Club along with the entry fee.
- 7) Each entry will contain 21 group selections (15 forwards, 3 defensemen and 3 goalies) and will be chosen from a prepared form whereby the contestant will select one player from each of 21 groupings of 5 comparable players.
- 8) There will be 7 prizes awarded at the conclusion of the contest for first \$1,000, second \$500, third \$350, fourth \$250, fifth \$150, sixth \$100, last \$100 and best points per game average \$250. There will be calendar monthly prizes for the first and second place winners (October, November, December, January, February & March) Each \$25. All prizes based upon HockeyDraft.ca statistics.
- 9) In the event of a tie, the number of winners will divide the prizes evenly (for example if 2 tie, we will add first and second prizes together and divide by 2).
- 10) All statistical information on the NHL scoring race will be provided by HockeyDraft.ca and will be accessible online by logging onto the website of HockeyDraft.ca to review their points with the username “2023RotaryHockeyPool”, pool password “rotary” (case sensitive).
