## Today's program: UA Museum of the North paleontology updates and recent finds with Dr. Patrick Druckenmiller



Patrick Druckenmiller is Director of the University of Alaska Museum and Professor of Geology at the University of Alaska Fairbanks. He received his BA at the University of Wisconsin Madison, his MS at Montana State University Bozeman, and his PhD at the University of Calgary, Alberta.

Pat's research focuses on Mesozoic marine reptiles and dinosaurs, particularly those from high latitudes. He oversees numerous field-based projects across Alaska, particularly on Arctic dinosaurs from the North Slope and in Denali National Park and Preserve. He is also a collaborator on several marine reptile projects at various international sites, including Svalbard, Norway and more recently, China.

In 2018, Pat took on directorship of the UA Museum, which hosts ten diverse research collections, provides important educational opportunities and welcomes nearly 90,000 visitors annually. Pat resides in

Fairbanks with his wife and daughter and is an avid cross-country skier and mountain biker.

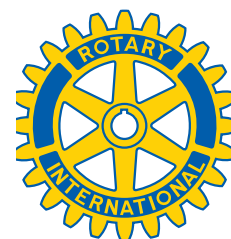
## Rotary After Hours Event at the Fairbanks Curling Club
