PRESENTED BY JAY JACKSON

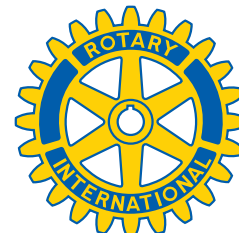
Linda “Jay” Jackson is the founder and executive director of Helping Hands for Nepal, Inc, a humanitarian non-profit which has developed projects in medicine, education, water and sanitation in Nepal since 1999.



She received her BA in Dramatic Arts from Whitman College and an MFA from UAF. Jackson was the special assistant for international relations to Anchorage Mayor Dan Sullivan and has been an intercultural consultant. She is an honorary member of the Anchorage East Rotary Club.

Jackson will provide a summary of the damage from the 2015 earthquake. Helping Hands for Nepal was one of the first responders on the scene. She will give an overview of aid so far, why it is so slow, and current needs.

HHN is currently working with the remote village of Samagaun, the second-to-last village in northern Gorkha in front of the Tibetan border. This is a village of 1200 sherpas, mostly Tibetan Buddhists. HHN is currently working on education needs and would like to do a community development project to help lift them out of dire poverty.
